



Nightshade

Toxic annual weed that inhabits pastures, roadsides, fence lines, and woodlands.

Toxicity:

- Primarily the berries, particularly the green berries.
- Leaves can be toxic, less so.
- Unpalatable to animals, so not typically consumed.
- Can cause gastric distress and weight loss, acutely.

Features:

- Leaves are alternate, smooth, and green.
- White flower with five petals.
- Green, immature berries and black, mature berries.
- 1.5-3 feet tall.

Control:

- Scout often, hand pull.
- Glyphosate
- GrazonNext HL
- Milestone
- 2,4-D + Dicamba
- Pasturegard
- Triclopyr
