He was a veteran and pilot of World War II, having served in the U.S. Navy.


Dr. Gary W. Simone

Dr. Herb Chapman, Jr. 91




Passed on Friday, January 16, 2015.

GODWIN, GRANT MURRAY




Graduated from the University of Florida, and worked for 4-H, IFAS at the University of Florida.

Retired after 33 years of service.


Adam "A.T." Tucker, 90

Director from 1974 - 1980




Lenzy Maurice Scott
