between growers and the faculty at SWFREC.

On other fronts, I have been actively involved, previously as the Southern Regional Director for the National Association of County Agricultural Agents (NACAA) and more recently in the NACAA officer rotation.

I will preside over the NACAA Annual Meeting and Professional Improvement Conference, in Virginia Beach, in July 2020.

As you may know, the presidentselect, presidents and past-presidents of the various extension professional societies are automatically seated on the Board of the Joint Council of Extension Professionals (JCEP). As president-elect, this past year I took my place on the JCEP Board and was nominated and elected by my peers to serve as President-elect of JCEP in 2020 and will become President in 2021. I am happy and honored to be at a point in my career to be able to assume a leadership role and give back in measure to these professional societies that have assisted me throughout my career.

On a personal note, my wife Donna and I remain on our ranch outside LaBelle and are fortunate that two of our sons and their wives and children also live in LaBelle. We enjoy visiting with them and our three grandchildren, Molly, Vaughan and Emma. Our youngest son Andy is currently in Atlanta where he is pursuing a PhD in biochemistry at Georgia Tech.
