

COVID-19 Testing

for Agricultural Workers

Frequently Asked Questions (FAQ)

Q: How much does the test cost?

A: The test is free for the employer, farm worker and their families.

Q: How do farmers, farm labor contractors, and agriculture workers participate in this COVID-19 testing initiative?

A: Testing sites will be open for walk-up and appointments. Mobile testing for groups may be available to come to your work site. Please read the flyer for information on the testing schedule and to schedule an appointment for individuals or groups.

Q: Can agriculture workers bring their family members to this testing site to also get tested?

A: Yes, and at no cost.

Q: What information is needed to participate in the event?

A: Name, date of birth and phone number. A face mask will be required to wear at testing site.

Q: How do you get test results?

A: Results will only be shared with the individual tested or someone who has been designated by the individual to receive the results on their behalf.

Q: What should the employer do when a worker notifies them of a positive COVID-19 test?

A: Employers should work directly with their local health department on the screening, isolation and quarantine process, and housing needs of their agriculture workers. Employers should follow, as feasible, the guidance provided by the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC) for "Agricultural Workers and Employers" that is available on the CDC website.
