Objective

The *Growing Together:* Glades County 4-H supporter newsletter was created to keep our supporters and community partners informed and engaged year-round with the Glades County 4-H program. This publication highlights how their contributions directly impact local youth by providing enriching programming opportunities across the county. Recognizing that our supporters generously come together each year to purchase the Glades County Chapter hog, this newsletter was developed to ensure they remain connected to the program beyond show time, fostering a sense of inclusion and appreciation throughout the year.

Target Audience

The target audience for this periodical publication was supporters of the Glades County 4-H program. Specifically, those supporting our chapter hog fundraiser, advisory committee members, and county commissioners are included. According to the latest United States Census Quickfacts data, as of July 2019, Glades County's population totaled 13,811. The county's demographic breakdown reveals 78.8% Caucasian, 13.7% African American, 5.2% American Indian, 21.8% Hispanic, and 0.7% Asian residents.

Methods Used

The *Growing Together: Glades County 4-H* newsletter was expertly designed using Canva as the primary platform. This visually engaging publication incorporated photos to showcase ongoing 4-H activities while highlighting opportunities available to youth, made possible through the generous support of our community partners.

Impact Results

In its second year, the *Growing Together: Glades County 4-H* newsletter, launched in 2023, has played a vital role in strengthening community engagement and support. In its inaugural year, local supporters contributed \$14,022 to the Glades County 4-H program. By 2024, that support nearly doubled to \$27,522. While multiple factors influence donor contributions, the newsletter has been a powerful tool in informing supporters about how their generosity directly benefits 4-H youth programs. By fostering transparency and ongoing communication, the newsletter has helped cultivate a deeper connection between our supporters and the impact of their contributions.

Applicant's Role in the Entry

The applicant carefully curated the newsletters by collecting photos and stories from various 4-H clubs and activities, ensuring a dynamic and engaging showcase of the program's impact.

Publisher's Requirement

The *Growing Together: Glades County 4-H* Newsletter was not subject to specific publishing requirements. However, as a component of the University of Florida, it is obligatory to incorporate the Affirmative Action statement in each publication.

Production Costs

The periodical publications were meticulously crafted using computers within the County Extension Office and leveraging the cost-free resources available on the CANVA website, resulting in no financial burden for the applicants. Distribution of the newsletters was facilitated through traditional mailings via USPS. Printed copies were provided to all Glades County 4-H supporters, with in-house printing funded by county resources, thus eliminating printing expenses. Furthermore, postage fees were covered by University postage funds, further minimizing costs. If produced externally, the estimated cost per newsletter, including printing and postage, would amount to approximately \$2.00 per supporter.
